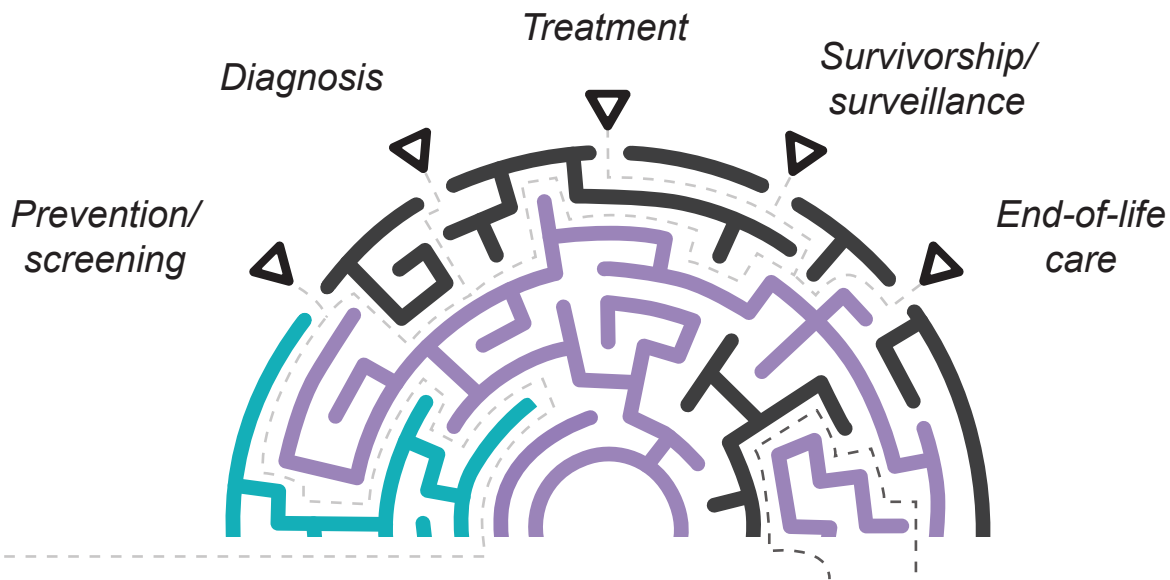
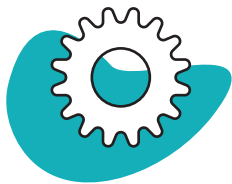


Indigenous Peoples face barriers to accessing cancer care at every point in the cancer journey

- Lack of access to primary care
- Care that is not culturally safe
- Complex health system design and poorly coordinated care



INDIVIDUAL

- Inequity in determinants of health
- Challenges with communication from providers
- Lack of appropriate support
- Lack of transportation
- Poverty, Racism



STRUCTURAL

- Jurisdictional ambiguities
- Socioeconomic conditions
- Systemic racism
- Colonial policies
- Historical trauma
